China Clean Energy Appoints New Independent Auditor

Fuqing City, China – January 8, 2010 -- China Clean Energy Inc. (OTC Bulletin Board: CCGY.OB) (“China Clean Energy”, the “Company”), a producer of biodiesel fuel and environmentally-friendly specialty-chemical products made from renewable resources in The People’s Republic of China (“PRC”), announced today that the Company engaged Frazer Frost, LLP (“Frazer Frost”) as its new independent auditor for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009, effective January 1, 2010.
